



Preparation requirements for Pest Control/ Fumigation Services

To ensure the effectiveness of the treatment and the safety of your household, we kindly ask you to follow the instructions below to prepare your unit:

- Remove or cover food and utensils.
- Remove all food items, utensils, and cookware from counter tops and exposed surfaces.
- Store food in sealed containers or remove it from the unit.
- Alternatively, cover all food and utensils with plastic sheeting or airtight coverings.
- Clear access to areas where pests may be hiding (e.g., along walls, under sinks, behind appliances, inside closets).
- Move furniture and appliances (if possible) at least 2 feet away from walls to allow technicians full access to baseboards and corners.
- All pets (including fish tanks) must be removed or properly secured in a safe area outside
 the treatment zone. For fish tanks, make sure they are tightly covered, and turn off aerators
 if possible.
- Cover or remove clothing, bedding, and other personal items to prevent them from coming into contact with the treatment chemicals.
- Store children's toys and other belongings in sealed bags or containers.
- For your safety, it is essential that all occupants leave the unit during the fumigation. You
 may return to your unit [2 hours] after the service is completed, or as specified by the pest
 control team.
- After the fumigation process, open windows and doors upon your return to air out the unit before reentering.
